WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE LIFE OF THE CHAELI CAMPAIGN

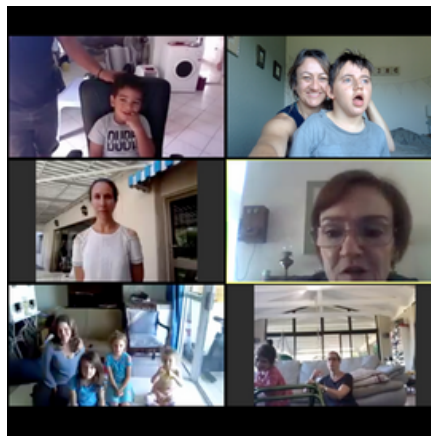
